About the research

The findings in this report are from online interviews undertaken by <u>B2B International</u> in June and July 2020 with sustainability and corporate responsibility professionals in companies in France, Germany, Mexico, Singapore, Spain and the UK. The focus was on large companies with at least 1,000 employees, and operating in a wide range of sectors.

Breakdown of participants by company size:

- 46% of respondents were in companies with 1,000 to 2,499 employees
- 25% of respondents were in companies with 2,500 to 4,999 employees
- 15% of respondents were in companies with 5,000 to 10,000 employees
- 14% of respondents were in companies with more than 10.000 employees

Breakdown of participants by sector:

- Business and financial services, IT and Telecoms 20%
- Manufacturing 22%
- Construction, engineering and mining 15%
- Public sector and education 10%
- Healthcare 9%
- Wholesale and retail 7%
- Transport, storage and communication 7%
- Other 10%



How are your environmental management and/or sustainability priorities likely to change as a result of Covid-19?



How are your environmental management and/or sustainability priorities likely to change as a result of Covid-19?



How are your customers attitudes to sustainability likely to change as a result of Covid-19?



How much of a disruption has Covid-19 caused to your organisation?




- The outbreak has helped our business

How are your environmental management and/or sustainability priorities likely to change as a result of Covid-19?





How is your organisation's total budget for sustainability likely to change as a result of Covid-19?




Who we've spoken to: staff and strategy


